

# No Surprise Act

You have the right to **know how much your health care will cost**. This is called a "Good Faith Estimate (GFE)."

- ✓ Health care providers must give uninsured and self-pay clients an estimate of expected charges for services.
- ✓ Information about service costs will be provided **orally** and in writing at least one day before scheduled dates of service. This estimate is also available if requested anytime.
- ✓ Costs for one-hour visits are posted online and include a minimal credit card fee. Additional time beyond one hour will incur additional charges.
- ✓ Your Good Faith Estimate (GFE) will also be shared through your client portal after provided orally. Please sign this form electronically and save a copy for your records.
- ✓ If your bill is at least \$400 more than your GFE, you have the option to dispute it. For more information, visit [www.cms.gov/nosurprises](http://www.cms.gov/nosurprises).
